Will Angola increase its natural gas share by 2025?

Angola targets increasing natural gas's share in its energy mix to 25% by 2025, up from the current 7%-10%. Key initiatives include the Sanha Lean Gas Connection Project by Chevron, set to deliver 600 mmscf/d to Angola LNG by the end of 2024, and a comprehensive Gas Master Plan (GMP) outlining a 25-year strategy to develop over 40 gas fields.

Angola is gearing up for a transformative year in 2025, marked by key developments in oil, natural gas, and renewable energy. With a strong focus on maintaining crude production above one million barrels per day (bpd) and diversifying its energy mix, the country is advancing projects in green hydrogen, solar energy, and natural gas.

How much money will Angola invest in natural gas?
