Can I use a power outlet in Haiti?

Using a Power Outlet: Most electrical outlets in Haiti operate on 110-120 volts AC, which is the standard voltage used in North America. Therefore, you can use the charger and cable provided with your device directly into the power outlet. However, you might need a plug adapter if the outlet's shape or pins are different from those of your charger.
