Does Cape Town have a solar project?

The City of Cape Town recently unveiled an R14.6 million ground-mounted solar project, Cape {town} Etc reports. The 990kWp renewable energy project at the Kraaifontein Wastewater Treatment Plant forms part of the City's solar PV drive for increased energy security. Is Cape Town the first city in South Africa to own a solar plant?

Cape Town is set to become the first city in South Africa to own and operate its own solar plant. Construction is now underway on the city's own 7 MW facility, which will have potential to scale up to 10 MW. It is located in the town of Atlantis, around 40 km north of the city.

Why is Cape Town building its first solar plant in Atlantis?

Picture: Supplied Cape Town has started building its first solar photovoltaic (PV) plant in Atlantis, marking a milestone in its efforts to diversify energy resources and reduce reliance on Eskom's power supply. The 7MW-10MW plant is the first utility-scale solar project owned and operated by a South African municipality.
