



Solomon Islands Hospital Solar System Project

The project will assist Solomon Islands install solar power hybrid grids, including battery storage, to replace diesel generation. Following the project, an estimated 78% of power generated at the five targeted provincial grids will be from solar power. Project preparatory technical assistance was used in project preparation.^{1 2}.
